

Access Protocol

I. With the signing of the October 2009 Memorandum of Understanding and in consideration of the Province's remediation of the shoreline erosion and dump site contamination, Tobique First Nation will ensure NB Power has unrestricted access to the Tobique Dam.

II. Access to Tobique residences will continue to be restricted, however,

a. In the event of an emergency, to access residences in the Tobique territory, NB Power will call one or more of the following contacts and report to the an area designated in writing by Tobique First Nation before entering the community:

III. In the event discussions falter or stall on the priorities agreed upon in the 'whereas' clauses of the October 2009 Memorandum of Understanding between Tobique and the Province:

- a. the Province will continue with remediation of the river bank erosion and dump site contamination, and
- b. Tobique First Nation will continue to ensure NB Power has unrestricted access to the Tobique Dam. Access to Tobique residences will continue to be restricted.

IV. This Protocol can only be amended the Chief of Tobique First Nation and the Deputy Minister of Aboriginal Affairs Secretariat.
